<p>Speak It!</p>  <p>Free Extension</p>	<p>Text-to-Speech Only reads accessible text (text that can be highlighted.)</p>	<p>Highlight text to read, then right click and choose Speak It!</p>
<p>Annuncify!</p>  <p>Free Extension</p>	<p>Text-to-Speech Only reads accessible text (text that can be highlighted.)</p>	


<p><u>Mercury Reader</u></p>  <p>Free Extension</p>	<p>Clears visually distracting material from web based articles.</p>	
<p><u>BeeLine Reader</u></p>  <p>Free Extension</p>	<p>Changes the color of the font by adding a gradient color to text.</p>	<p>Helps the eye track across page.</p>
<p><u>Rewordify</u> - Free</p>  <p>Website</p>	<p>Identifies the difficult words in the passage and puts it into simpler terms.</p>	<p>Copy and paste writing into the program.</p>

<p><u>Shahi -</u></p>  <p>Website</p>	<p>Free visual dictionary.</p>	<p>Uses Flickr images and some are NOT appropriate!</p>
<p><u>Holt Interactive Graphic Organizers</u></p>  <p>Website</p>	<p>Interactive graphic organizers.</p>	
<p><u>Sas Writing Navigator</u></p>  <p>Free App</p>	<p>Walks students through the writing process.</p>	<p>Need to log-in with a free account.</p>
<p><u>Mindmup</u></p>  <p>Free App</p>	<p>Graphic organizers.</p>	<p>Looks very similar to</p>
<p><u>Awesome Screenshot</u></p>  <p>Free Extension</p>	<p>Take a screenshot, then use the pop up toolbar to draw, annotate, highlight and blur items.</p>
