To provide optimum learning opportunities, school teams need information about all aspects of the student's educational needs in order to identify and provide appropriate instruction and supports. The diagnosticians on the Deaf and Hard of Hearing Diagnostic Team provide consultation, evaluation, and interpretation of assessment results to help school teams better understand the impact of the hearing loss on the student's academic, cognitive, functional, communicative, and social-emotional development.

Focus

The Deaf and Hard of Hearing Diagnostic Team provides a wide-range of assessments for students with hearing losses that include audiological evaluations, psychological evaluations, speech-language evaluations, social developmental histories, play-based assessments, as well as the assessment and management of assistive listening devices. The team provides in-service training for school personnel on the impact a hearing loss plays in academic, speech, language, social emotional and cognitive development.

Who We Are

The Deaf/Hard of Hearing Diagnostic Team consists of licensed audiologists, clinical psychologist and a ALD Technician, as well as highly qualified speech/language pathologists and social worker. All diagnostic team members are trained in communication methodologies to provide in depth evaluations specific to each students communication needs. The team is knowledgeable and experienced in amplification, cochlear implants, and the impact a hearing loss has on language, speech, and academic development.
