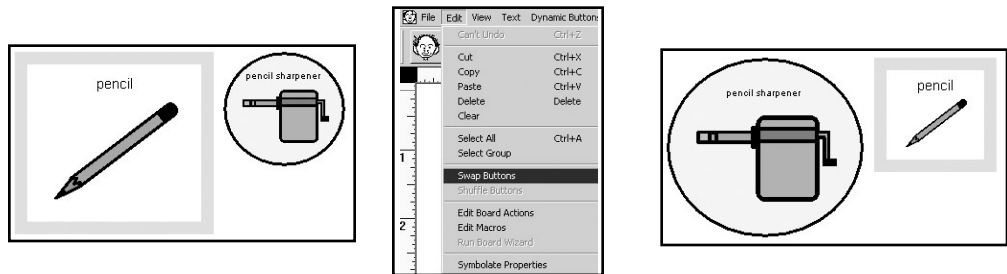

Swapping Two Buttons

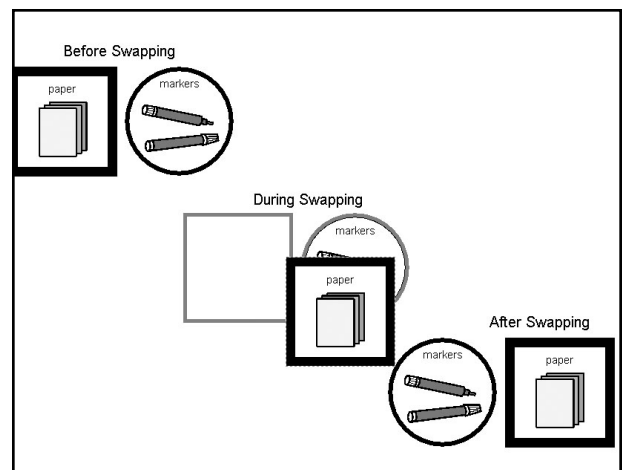
- a. Select the two buttons that you want to swap.
 - b. Go to **Edit** and select **Swap Buttons**.
- * The button position and sizes will remain constant but the content (symbols, text and lines), characteristics (colors, border thickness, border shadow and corner shape), and actions (for Boardmaker Plus and SDPro) will be swapped. If the buttons are different sizes, the content will be scaled to fit the buttons.

Swapping Shortcut

- a. Press and hold the **Alt** key, on your keyboard.
 - b. While continuing to hold the **Alt** key, **click and drag** one of the buttons as if you were going to move it. A “ghost” highlight of the button will stay in its original position as you drag the button around (to remind you of its original position on the board).
 - c. Drag the button over top of the button you want to swap with. When your cursor is over a “swappable” button, that button will become highlighted.
 - d. Release the mouse button to swap the two buttons.
- * If you release the mouse button when the cursor is not over a swappable button, the original button will bounce back to its original location.



Shuffling Buttons

To randomly shuffle the contents of multiple buttons:

a. Select the buttons that you want shuffled.

b. Go to **Edit** and select **Shuffle Buttons**.

* As with the swap feature, the shuffled buttons can be of different sizes. The content will always get scaled appropriately.
