TOBLER-PATHS ATHLETIC FIELD RIBBON CUTTING CEREMONY

Julie Jilek shared that on Saturday, September 16th, NSSEO celebrated the opening of the Tobler-PATHS field. In attendance were the individuals responsible for turning a dream into reality: The Tobler Family; PATHS representatives, Nan Naranjo and Sandy Ricketts; Kirk Staff, Nick Mueller, Wendy Meyer, Kim Dungan and Jill Anderson; Board members, Alva Kreutzer, Janice Krinsky, and Anna Klimkowicz; Dist. 214 Board member Bill Dussling; NSSEO Buildings and Grounds staff; NSSEO staff; former and current students and families; the Arlington Heights Police Dept.; NSSEO Foundation member Jim Platt; and Anthony Malone, project Engineer.

The event recognized all of the individuals who made the field possible. A bench and plaque were dedicated in memory of the Tobler's mother.

NSSEO SHINING STAR

Nancy D'Andrea introduced Chris Evans, a former H.S. District 211 student from Miner School as the NSSEO Shining Star. Chris began his participation in the Secondary Transition Experience Program (STEP) in 2013 with his initial work experience in an in-school job for 1 hour each day. His transition from "student to worker" began. In August 2015, Chris left Miner School and transitioned to the New Endeavors Transition Program within H.S. District 211. With support and guidance from his school teams as well as his family, Chris secured a position at Northwest Community Hospital as a dining room attendant working 25 hours per week. Chris expressed his heartfelt appreciation to everyone that contributed to his success. The partnership and collaboration of Chris's family, District 211, NSSEO and Northwest Community Hospital working together exemplifies how NSSEO drives students with special needs to be actively engaged citizens.

2017 NSSEO SAFETY FAIR RECOGNITION

Julie Jilek presented a power point and video presentation on the NSSEO Safety Fair that was held at Miner School on September 14th with the support of the Arlington Heights Police and Fire Departments, Northwest Central Dispatch, the State's Attorney Office and the hard work of the NSSEO Safety Committee including Board member Carol Botwinski. The Safety Fair provided an opportunity for students to build strong partnerships with the local Fire and Police Departments; increase understanding of safety procedures for students and families; opportunities for students to increase positive interactions with fire fighters and police officers; and opportunities for fire fighters and police officers to gain an increased awareness and understanding of the complex needs of NSSEO students.

Jack O'Neal and Nancy Milne recognized students from Miner School, Joe Sungvoom, Max Mayer and Eric Melendes and from Timber Ridge School, Caitlyn Berowski who volunteered and took on leadership roles that helped facilitate activities and made strong connections with caring adults developing community partnerships.

SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT

FEDERAL/STATE UPDATE

Dr. Hackett provided an update on the many legislative educational issues and changes happening statewide. The Evidence Based Funding Formula and how it will affect Special Education across the state continues to be one of the major topics as well as major concerns regarding the growing mental health issues present within our schools. Dr. Hackett also shared highlights from the recently attended Illinois Alliance of Administrators Annual Fall Conference and the Illinois Association of School Administrators' Annual Conference.

KIRK SCHOOL PRINICIPAL SEARCH PROCESS

Heather Miehl stated that Kim Dungan will be retiring at the end of the 2017-2018 school year. The search and hiring process for this unique position began earlier in the month. The position was posted on October 2nd and will remain open until October 22nd. NSSEO leadership continues to gather input from staff, parents, and district leaders regarding the attributes and qualities that are important in this role. Heather stated that currently there are 9 (nine) candidates that have applied. The interview process will begin later this month with the final candidate interviewing with Dr. Hackett in November with the goal to bring a final recommendation to the Board in December.

PROGRAM TOURS

Heather Miehl stated that NSSEO is offering multiple opportunities for member districts, local and state legislators and Board members to engage in unique learning experiences within NSSEO classrooms and schools. Program visits to Kirk, Miner and Timber Ridge Schools were held on Friday, September 22^{nd.} A second tour for community leaders and Illinois legislators is scheduled for October 18th and a third tour for District 59 is scheduled for October 24th.

PERC UPDATE

Dr. Hackett shared that NSSEO's new Parent Education Resource Center (PERC) is set to officially open its doors on November 1, 2017. With support and contributions from the NSSEO Foundation and another very generous anonymous donor, PERC will be a place of connection, where parents can engage with educators, other parents and community partners to plan for the future needs of their children. PERC will be open daily from 10:00 am to 2:00 pm when school is in session. PERC will emulate the important future planning reflected in our NSSEO vision of "Enhancing students' talents and dreams for a promising future." Dr. Hackett extended an invitation to the Board to the PERC Open House on November 1st from 4:00 - 6:00 pm.

NSSEO HUMAN RESOURCES & COMMUNICATIONS UPDATE

FY 2017-18 MINER SCHOOL STAFFING PLAN REVISION

Danielle Carter explained that Miner School's staffing plan for the FY 2017-18 was based on 80.5 students. Current enrollment is 91 students with additional students being considered for the program. Due to the increased enrollment and the complexity and intensity of students' needs, an additional 1.0 FTE Building Assistant is being requested to provide additional support in order to meet students' educational needs.

It was moved by Anna Klimkowicz and seconded by Frank Fiarito to approve the request for an additional 1.0 FTE Building Assistant for Miner School for the 2017-2018 school year. On roll call vote – Ayes: Composto, Johannesen, Krinsky, Kreutzer, Harrison, Klimkowicz, and Fiarito. Nays: None.

NSSEO COMMUNICATIONS UPDATE

Danielle Carter shared that NSSEO is committed to provide stakeholders with timely, connected and meaningful information regarding programs and services, student and staff celebrations and updates. Communication will be provided on events held within the district as well as state and federal updates. Information will be sent out on a regular basis over the arch of the school year. Publications, newsletters and Board Briefs will act as vehicles for sharing how NSSEO and member districts engage, connect and grow to enhance student's talents and dreams for a promising future.

NSSEO BUSINESS DEPARTMENT UPDATE

FY 17-18 IDEA AND PRESCHOOL GRANT APPROVALS

Julie Jilek stated that NSSEO has received programmatic approval from ISBE for the FY17-18 IDEA Part B Flow-Through and Preschool Grants. A public announcement was posted in the local newspaper stating the receipt of the programmatic approval.


