# SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT

## FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT REQUEST

Dr. Hackett stated that NSSEO had received a request under the Freedom of Information Act and that the information requested was granted in part and denied in part.

#### SCHOOL FUNDING UPDATE

Dr. Hackett and Julie Jilek presented to the Board the recent changes to special education funding. A power point presentation highlighted the evidence-based funding model, mandated categorical reimbursements, maintenance of effort and site-based expenditure reporting. Public Act 100-0465 which became effective August 31, 2017 changed education funding distribution to local education agencies and included significant changes to the method of funding special education. In summary, Dr. Hackett and Ms. Jilek stated how important it is to be informed and engaged in discussions and planning, partner with districts, organizations and parents to ensure supports and resources continue to be present for students with special needs and to collaborate with state agencies and legislators to ensure the intent of the changes are reflected in practice.

# STANDARD MILEAGE RATE

Julie Jilek reported effective January 1, 2018 the IRS rate for travel has been increased to 54.5 cents per mile, up one (1) cent from the 2017 rate.

#### WATER SAMPLING RESULTS

Julie Jilek shared that on January 16, 2017, Governor Bruce Rauner signed Senate Bill 0550, Public Act 099-0922, the Lead in Drinking Water testing bill. The bill required all Pre-K to 5<sup>th</sup> grade schools to conduct a one-time test for lead in drinking water to be completed by December 31, 2017 for schools that were constructed prior to January 1, 1987. The Illinois Department of Public Health (IDPH) is the supervising agency for this bill. Julie Jilek reported that Professional Service Industries, Inc. conducted the water testing on Sunrise Lake Outdoor Education Center, NSSEO Administration Center, Timber Ridge School, Kirk School and Miner School. Ms. Jilek provided a summary of results and Actions taken. Results will be communicated to parents or guardians and posted on the district website as required by the statute.

#### HUMAN RESOURCES DEPARTMENT UPDATE

## FY 2017-208 TIMBER RIDGE SCHOOL STAFFING PLAN REVISION

Danielle Carter stated that the 2017-2018 staffing plan for Timber Ridge was based on 84.5 students. Due to an increase in students and additional students being considered for the program and the complexity and intensity of student needs, Timber Ridge will require an additional primary classroom. The additional classroom would provide the appropriate staff to student ratios which address the additional students' educational needs. Ms. Carter stated that in order to open a new classroom, new staff would be needed to support the students' learning and development.

It was moved by Anna Klimkowicz and seconded by Mark Hineman to approve the request for 1.0 FTE of Teacher, 1.0 FTE of Social Worker and 2.0 FTE of Classroom Aides at Timber Ridge School for the remainder of the 2017-2018 school year. On roll call vote — Ayes: Krinsky, Hineman, Johannesen, Botwinski, McAtee, Klimkowicz and Fiarito. Nays: None.

## NSSEO POLICY COMMITTEE UPDATE-FIRST READING

Danielle Carter stated that the Policy Committee met on Tuesday, January 9, 2018 to review and discuss the suggested changes made by PRESS Plus for revisions to the NSSEO Board Policy Manual. The committee made their recommendations to the Board for any changes or adoption of policies as presented. The policies will be presented for a second reading and approval at the February 7, 2018 NSSEO Governing Board meeting.
