Special Transportation—District Contracted Costs

If Districts outsource SPED transportation to a third party, as long as the contract states that the third party will provide the necessary equipment to transport a student, and ALL students require a physical modification that ride on that route, then that bus/route qualifies as specialized transportation.

Most District <u>Contracted Bussing</u> <u>routes</u> will not meet this requirement due to mixed student riders (special & specialized), so all contracted costs will need to be listed under (not only specialized trans).



Under the FY22 Tab, select Transportation Other Costs Page

Click on Transportation Services (not only specialized trans) link

Enter the annual contracted amount for special transportation in the Purchased Professional Services and/or Equipment box.

Be sure to list any expenses that were offset using Federal Grant funds.

Enter "zeros" in the remaining required boxes.


